Time to think about safety

Atherton Tablelands and Tully Mills were the first mills to get underway last week while Wilmar Sugar's Burdekin Mills started crushing this week and others quickly followed suit.

That means busy times in the paddocks and in the mills. Harvesters and cane haulout equipment may be invisible to you in the long cane so take due care coming around the end of a block. If you're using harvesting equipment, get a fix on the location of powerlines in your vicinity. Large farm equipment will also be moving slowly along and across roads, while cane trains will be beetling into the sidings and through road intersections. Please be aware, slow down and take care. Stay safe this season.

NSW weed management workshop a success

Thirty-five growers gathered in Harwood NSW last week for an advanced weed management workshop. It was run by SRA Weed Scientist Emilie Fillols with the assistance of representatives of Croplands and Nufarm. On the agenda was information to ensure growers achieve maximum impact with a herbicide. Growers were impressed by practical demonstrations of a temperature inversion, spray qualities that help reduce the risk of spray drift and examples of herbicide incompatibility. The growers have asked Emilie to come back in September for a pre-emergent herbicide workshop.
