2022 Season comes to a close

The results for the 2022 Season have been finalised and all QSL Growers have now received their final 2022-Season Advance payment.

The 2022 QSL Shared Pool finished at \$35.99/tonne actual* (including Loyalty Bonus), marking its third consecutive season above \$30/tonne.

The best performing 2022-Season QSL-managed pool was the US Quota, returning \$1129/tonne gross actual (\$980.48/t net IPS), with the QSL Harvest Pool returning \$636.11/tonne gross actual (\$649.75/t net IPS).
