



ADVANCED WORKSHOP ON KNOCKDOWN HERBICIDES

You're invited to our workshop to learn how to optimise your use of knockdown herbicides. SRA's Weed Scientist, Emilie Fillols, together with representatives from Nufarm, Malcolm Salisbury and Reannan Schultz, and Croplands, Rob Graham, will provide information on effective post emergent weed management in sugarcane.
