## WEAPONS SAFETY COURSES

Courses are conducted on a Saturday commencing at 8am to finish by 4pm, approximately. Prospective candidates are asked to register for attendance at a course as soon as possible with one of the presenters listed below with their contact details, enabling the presenters to plan for the next course and then advise, when known, the next course date, as there is not a course presented each month. The scheduling of courses will depend on numbers wishing to participate and the time available to the volunteer presenters. The present cost of the course is \$150.00 for the core module including Cat A, and B firearms.

Other modules are at \$30.00 each for each additional module if done at the same time. These are Cat C, D, and H. Our instructors and ranges are not approved for Cat M qualification however.

It is important that each attending candidate come to the Course with a photo I.D. (Driver's License or Student I.D. is excellent) and a personal Unique Student Identifier Number. Procedures necessary to obtain a Unique Student Identifier Number is found on the internet at the address shown below. It must be done personally, but is a simple procedure. It is possible that some of the candidates may already have a USI. The USI Website: [www.usi.gov.au/Students/Pages/steps-to-create-your-USI.aspx](http://www.usi.gov.au/Students/Pages/steps-to-create-your-USI.aspx). This USI requirement is something new and came into effect on 1st January 2015 and is now a requirement of all those persons doing recognised training delivered by a registered training organisation, such as ours.

For candidates having successfully completing the course, but not having their USI, Statements of Attainment cannot be issued until they have one. Issue will be delayed until the course presenters have a copy of these details, which will then be entered on the student's enrolment form, included with the paperwork sent to our Brisbane Office, for the issue of the Statement of Attainment in Weapons Safety. This normally takes 10 working days after the course has been successfully completed. On receipt of this Statement of Attainment, course participants may then apply for their desired Weapons Licenses.

Candidates are requested to bring their own lunch. Refrigeration and heating is available on site.
