

Reminder | Grower pricing deadlines

Individual Futures Contract and Self-Managed Harvest Contract

Any unpriced tonnage allocated to the July 2024 contract through the Individual Futures Contract and Self-Managed Harvest Contract after **this coming Thursday, 20 June 2024** will be priced by QSL at the next market opportunity. Growers can roll their exposure to the October 2024 contract before this date.

Target Price Contract

All unpriced 2024-Season tonnage in the Target Price Contract will automatically have its pricing window extended after **this coming Thursday, 20 June 2024** and roll adjustments will be applied. Indicative roll costs are available to QSL Direct growers against their open orders in their accounts or can be viewed by [clicking here](#).

2023 Season June Advance rate increase

Education | La Niña forecast for Brazil

A La Niña weather pattern is predicted to form over Brazil later this year – but what does that mean for the key sugar cane growing region of the Centre South?

Typically, La Niña brings increased rainfall to northern and northeastern Brazil, leading to a higher risk of flooding. Conversely, it often causes drier and colder conditions in southern Brazil, potentially resulting in droughts and impacting agriculture and water resources in the region.

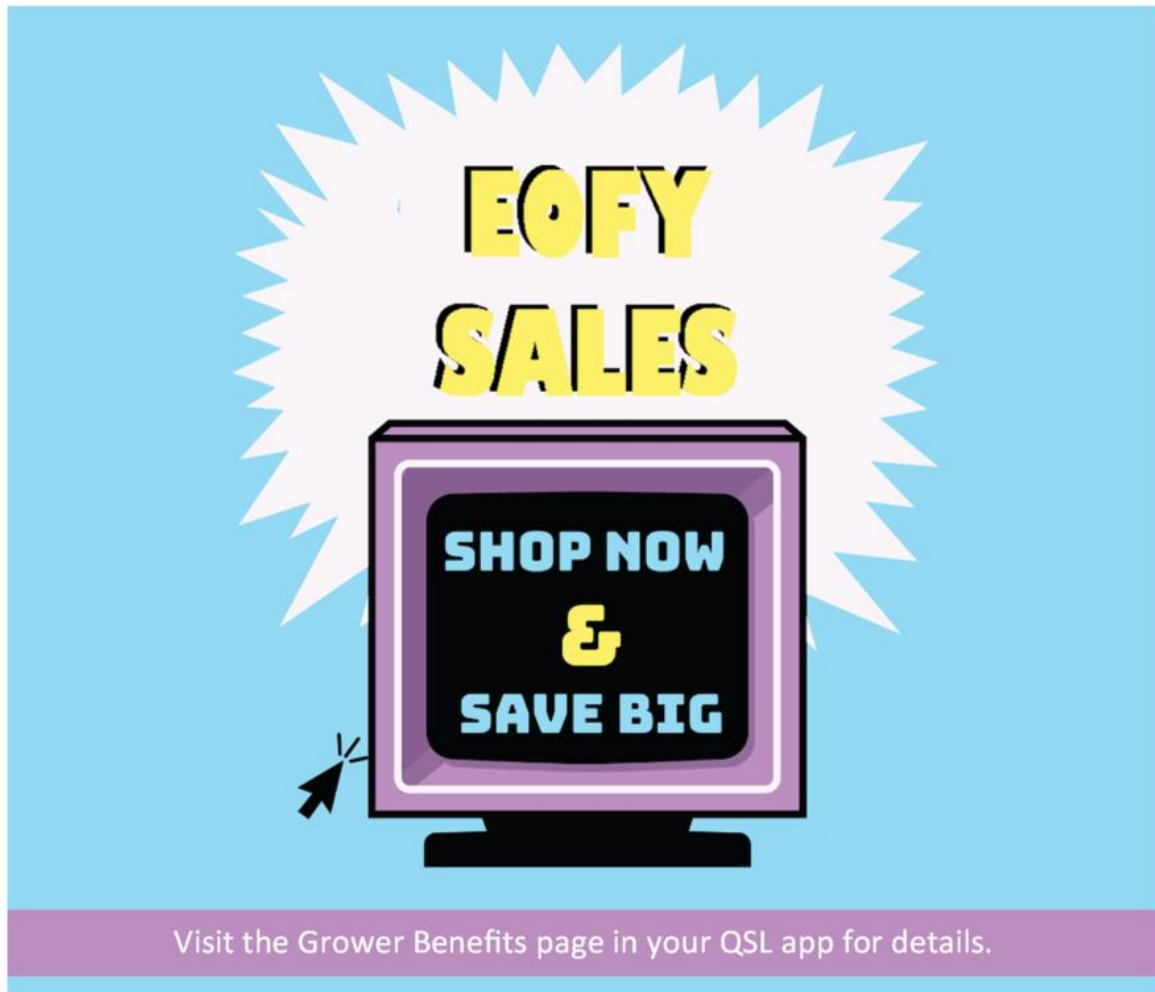
