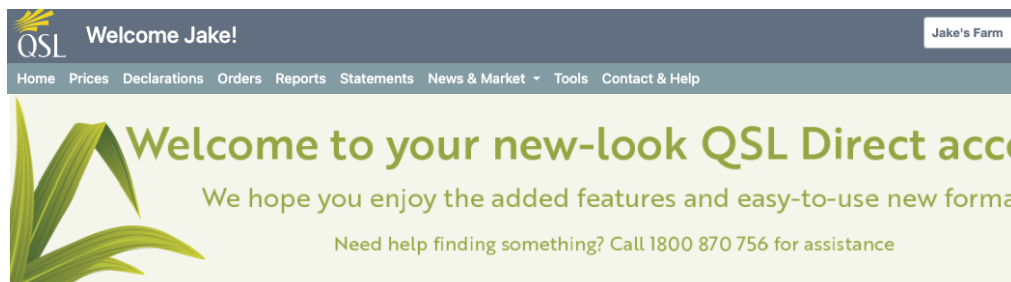

2023 Season June Advance rate increase

The 2023 QSL Standard Advance rate for June was confirmed last week and will increase to 97.5%, previously 95%, from 19 June.
