Comments:

Throughput was below budget this week following the wet weather stop.

Kalamia Mill was the first to come back online Sunday night, followed by Inkerman Mill on Monday morning. The remaining two factories were back in production by Wednesday.

Daily throughput ramped up as ground conditions improved.

Just over 207,000 tonnes of cane were processed for the week, bringing the season-to-date total for the Burdekin factories to almost 780,000 tonnes. This represents just over 9% of the budgeted crop.

The average weekly CCS was 13.42, which was above budget, despite the wet weather impacts.

The highest CCS sample of 16.2 was from a rake of Q183-P in the Mulgrave (Invicta) productivity district.

No incidents were reported on the cane rail network over the school holiday period.
