Comments:

The Burdekin mills processed just over 355,000 tonnes of cane for the week, which was below budget.

The four factories have now crushed more than 2.1M tonnes of cane for the season to date, which represents just over 25 per cent of the forecast crop.

Production was impacted this week by a number of planned and unplanned stops as well as industrial action. The opportunity was taken during the stoppages to carry out necessary maintenance work.

The average weekly CCS was 14.44, which was above budget.

The highest CCS sample of 17.6 was from a rake of Q183-PL in the Colevale (Pioneer) productivity district.

As always, please remember to take care as you approach cane rail crossings.

Our cane trains operate 24 hours a day, seven days a week during the season.
