Comments:
The Burdekin mills processed just over 329,000 tonnes of cane for the week. This brings the total for the season to 6.12M tonnes or 75% of the forecast crop.

Overall throughput was below budget this week. Inkerman had an extended cleaning intermission to carry out necessary repairs. Invicta also had a B side clean but also experienced unplanned stops around the pan stage and had a power blackout. Pioneer was going well until a bagasse reclaim arm broke. Kalamia had the biggest stop of nearly 48 hours after a high speed gearing shaft broke at #5 mill.

CCS levels are back to budget at Invicta and Pioneer, Inkerman and Kalamia are recovering slowly with the hot dry conditions
