

## BURDEKIN GROWER UPDATE



**Wednesday, 18 December 2024**

Wet weather has continued to restrict harvesting in the **Kalamia Mill** area, and we have made the decision not to restart crushing operations at that factory.

We have consulted with grower representatives to advise that we will **finish operations at Kalamia Mill today** due to there being an inadequate amount of cane being supplied to the factory on a regular basis to support the commercially justified operation of the mill.

Any remaining cane that can be harvested in the Kalamia Mill area can be transferred to Invicta Mill for processing, provided that factory is still operating.

Invicta, Pioneer and Inkerman mills will remain open as long as there are sufficient tonnes of cane being supplied on a regular basis to operate on a commercially justified basis.
